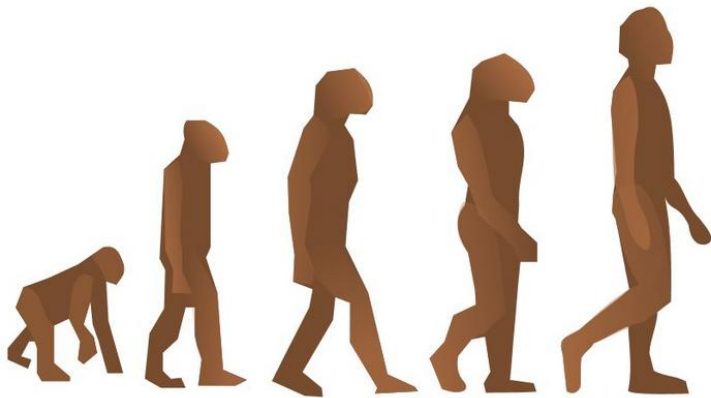

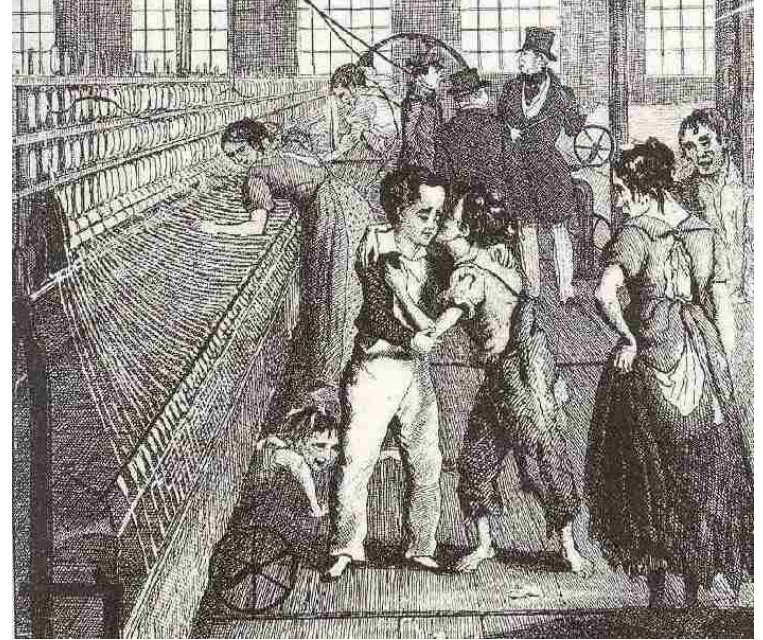

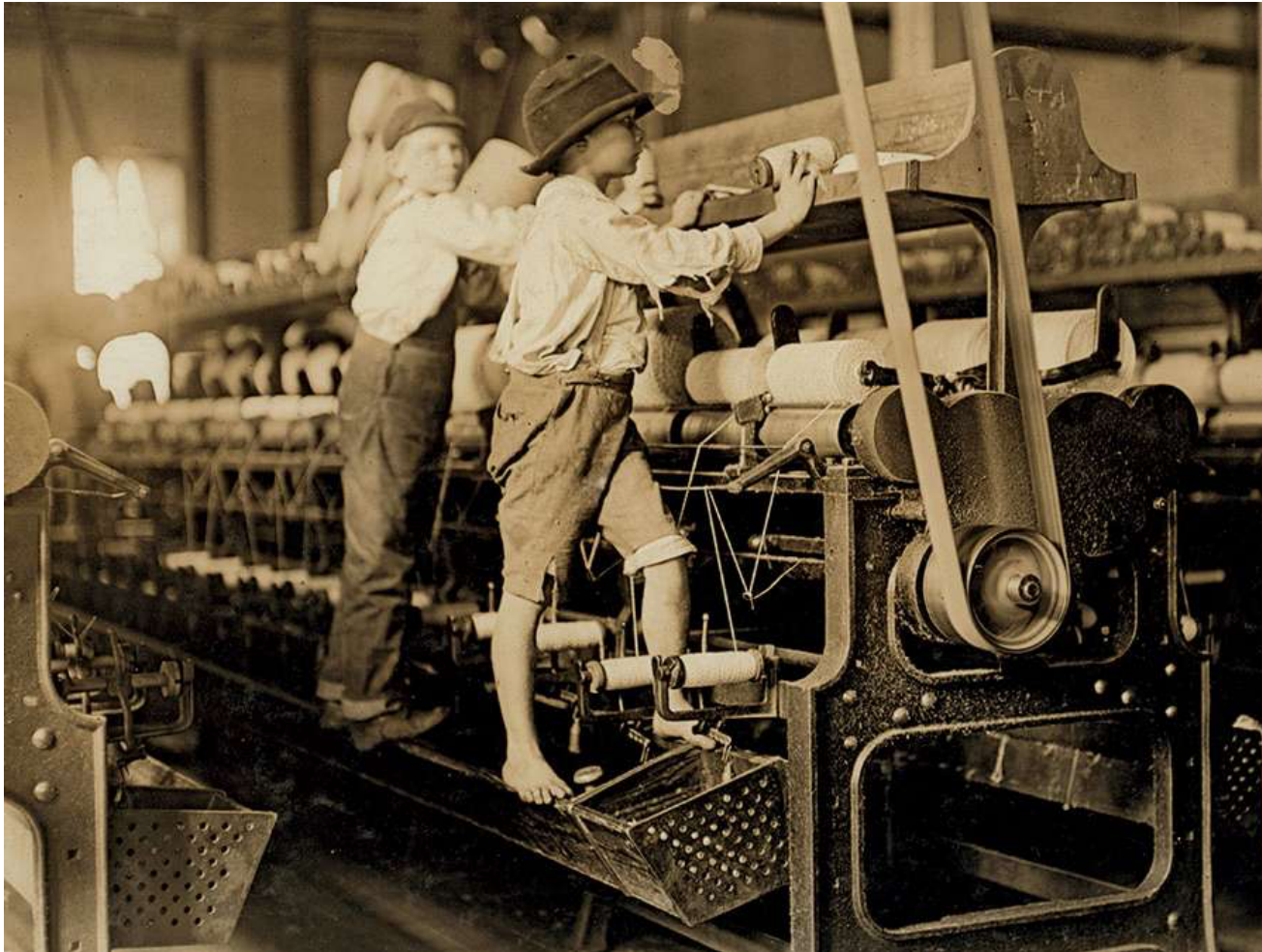


What does 'Industrial' mean?

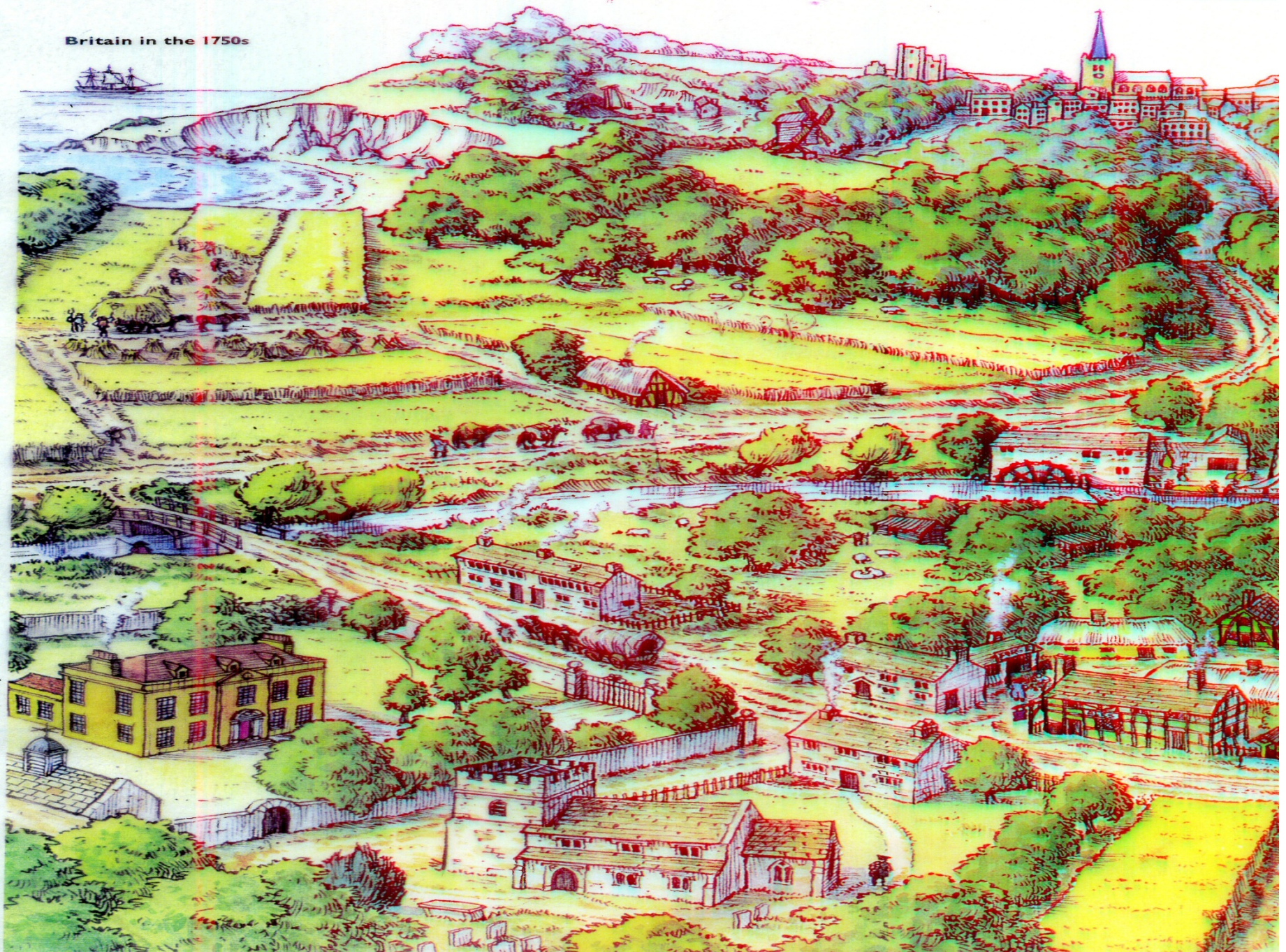

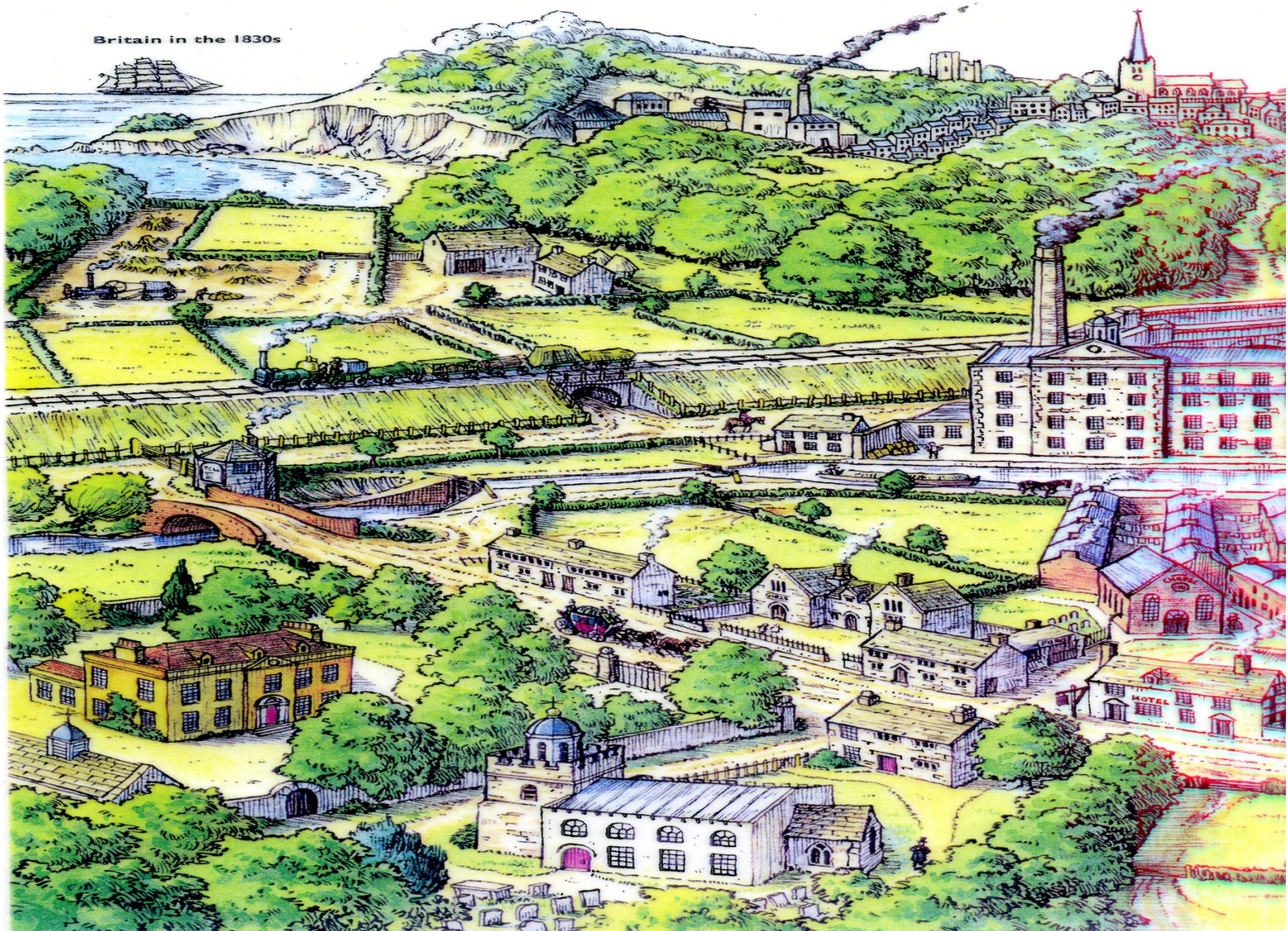

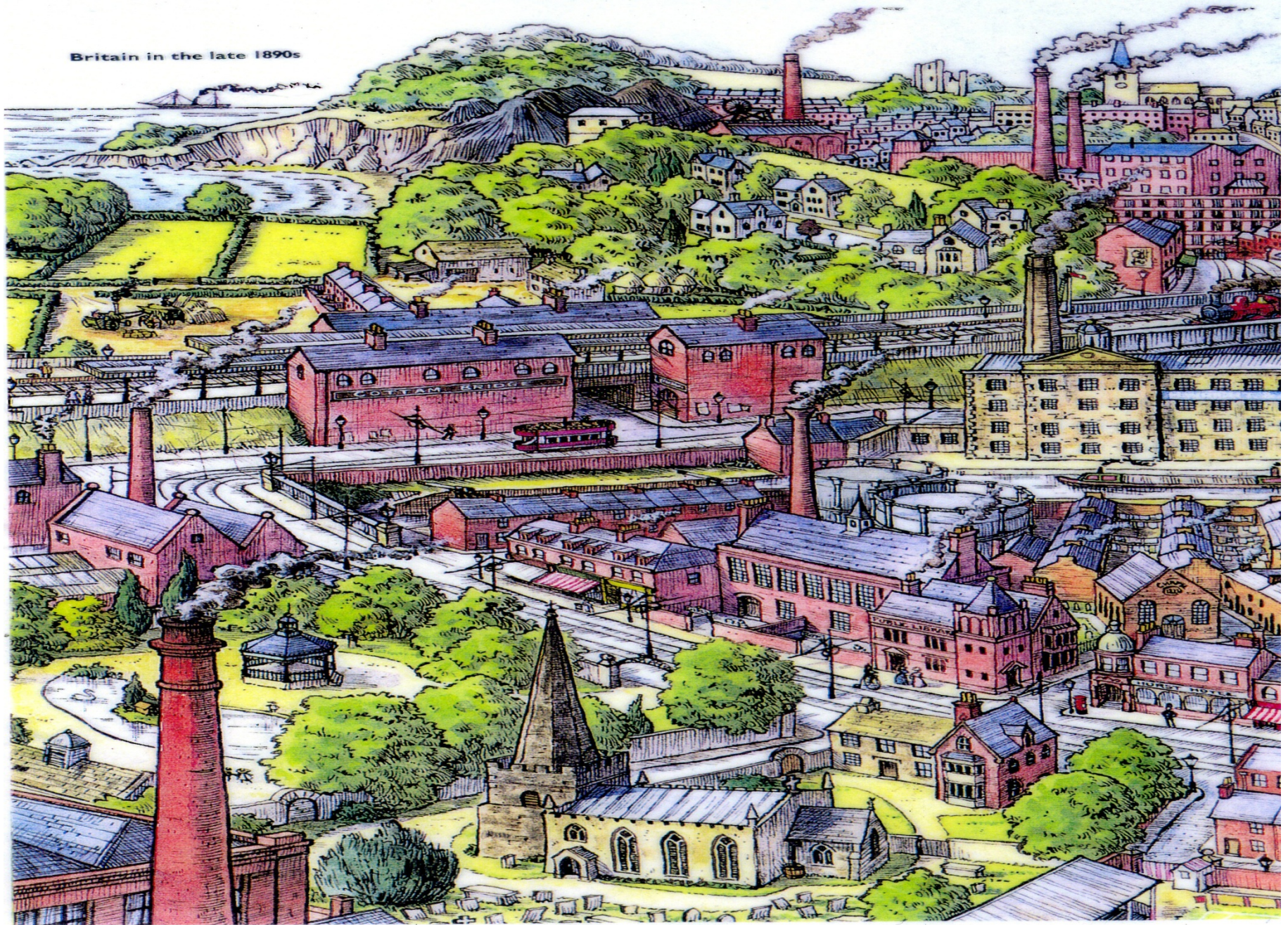
Britain in the 1750s

What can you learn from this source?

Use specific information from the source in your answer. You should make 4 detailed points.

Eg: "I can learn from this source that the population rose from 7 million in 1750 to 37 million in 1900..."

Extra Challenge: Include an inference for each point

Eg: "From this population rise I can infer that living conditions and medicine must have improved."
